Fishing



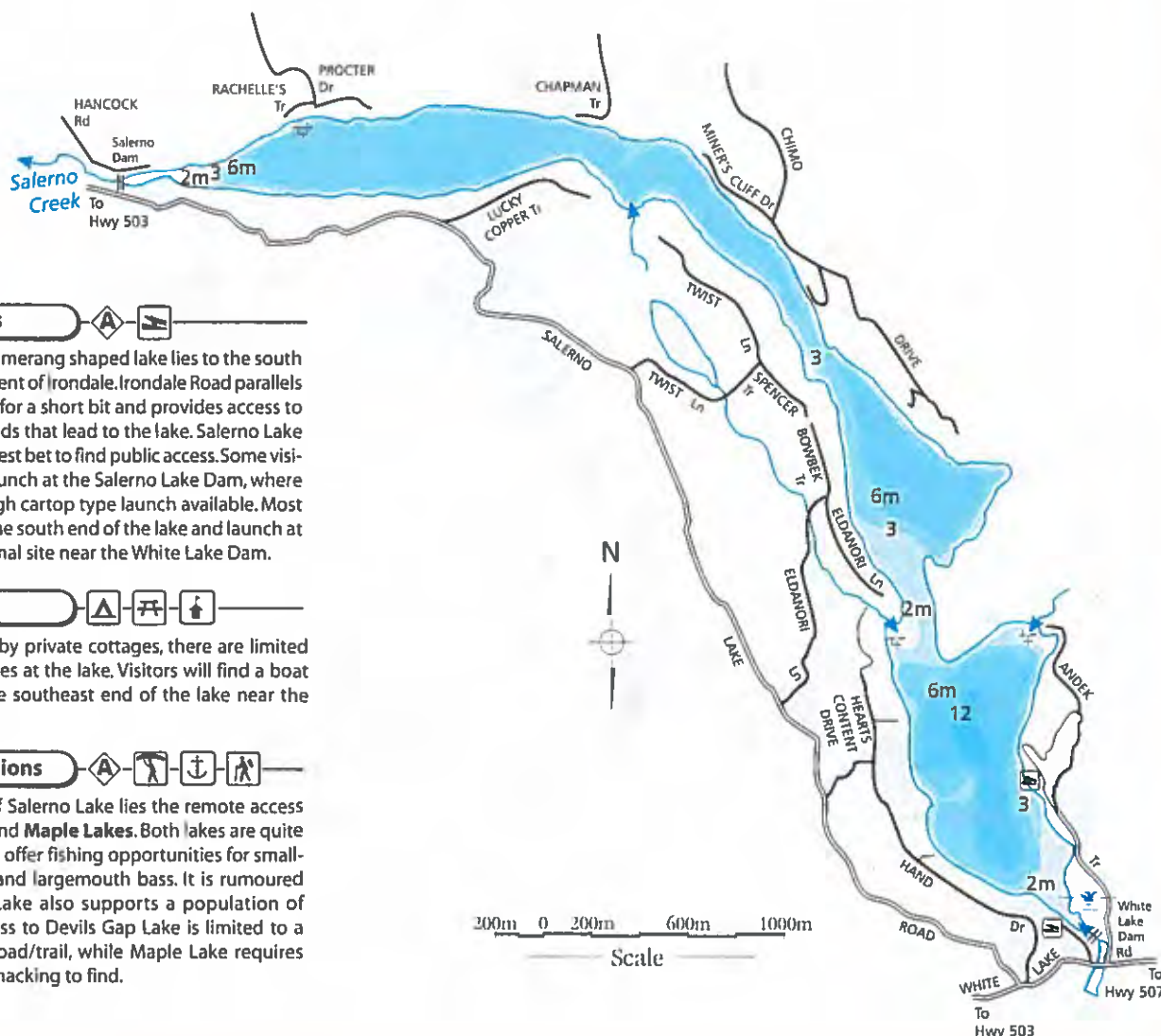
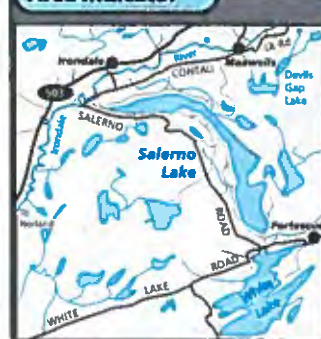
This long, narrow, shallow lake resembles a wide river. It's even set in a broad valley much like a river valley. The lake was formerly called Devil's Lake, and has water that is stained the colour of weak coffee. Although development has taken its toll on this once fantastic fishing lake, more and more anglers have started to practice catch and release and the fishing quality has been slowly improving at the lake over the past few years.

Anglers visiting Salerno Lake can expect to find mainly smallmouth and largemouth bass. The shallow, weedy nature of the lake is prime habitat for bass and anglers should work weed areas for the best results. Try stripping a streamer pattern or a brighter coloured jig through the weeds for ambush ready bass. During slower times, a tube jig can work quite well.

Walleye fishing in Salerno Lake is definitely slower than success for bass. Walleye can be found cruising the weed lines during the evening period. Trolling a worm harness slowly along these weed lines or still jigging off a shoal can be effective. One hot spot for walleye is the 3 m (10 ft) shoal found in the southwestern end of the lake. Fall is one of the best time to fish for walleye. Not only are the walleye bulking up for winter and usually extremely willing to hit anything that moves, but there are no launch line-ups, no pleasure boaters out scaring the fish. As the water gets colder, walleye move deeper, where temperatures are more stable. The majority concentrate along the edge of drop-offs, making them fairly easy to find.

While muskellunge are present in Salerno Lake, the average angler may have a tough time finding them. Try working a jointed Rapala in a Fire Tiger pattern, or an X-Rap Jointed Shad in Gold. The jointed lures have a very pronounced swimming motion which can draw strikes from these big predators, especially in the fall. Muskie are very sensitive to sound, and scatter when they hear a boat approaching. They will return to where they were once the boat has past, but it is good to have your lure at least 70 m (200 ft) behind the boat.

This long, boomerang shaped lake lies to the south of the settlement of Irondale. Irondale Road parallels Highway 503 for a short bit and provides access to a few side roads that lead to the lake. Salerno Lake Road is your best bet to find public access. Some visitors simply launch at the Salerno Lake Dam, where there is a rough cartop type launch available. Most continue to the south end of the lake and launch at the more formal site near the White Lake Dam.

Facilities



Surrounded by private cottages, there are limited public facilities at the lake. Visitors will find a boat launch at the southeast end of the lake near the dam.

Other Options



To the east of Salerno Lake lies the remote access Devils Gap and Maple Lakes. Both lakes are quite secluded and offer fishing opportunities for smallmouth bass and largemouth bass. It is rumoured that Maple Lake also supports a population of walleye. Access to Devils Gap Lake is limited to a rough 4wd road/trail, while Maple Lake requires some bushwhacking to find.
